The peyote stich is a versatile stitch, but the patterns can be difficult to read. The hands-on program provided instruction and practice to members in learning to read peyote patterns. Members started the process with practicing the peyote stich using Perler beads in place of Japanese cylinder beads and with a simple peyote pattern. Table captains then introduced a second, more complex pattern. Members were given a kit to take home that contained Delicas in order to complete the last pattern in the instruction packet, a leaf. Cindy Collins announced that there would be a "Peyote Corner" at the Fall Bead-In for members seeking assistance.
