Classes will be held in classroom NDH-063. Notre Dame Hall is #1 on the map. It is the building with the tall bell tower. Access the campus from Menomonee River Pkwy (not visible in this picture) on the west side of the grounds. There is a door on the northwest side of the hall, near the #13 on the map; that is the closest entrance for the classroom we are using. Enter this door, go down the stairs, and turn left. The classroom is on your left.

For handicap entry to the classroom – access the campus from North 92nd St (shown on the top of this picture). Park in the parking lot near Gerhardinger Center. Enter Gerhardinger Center through the Café (there is a campus sign right outside the building). Turn right and follow the hallway as it curves to the left. Ahead of you is the elevator. Take the elevator to the basement (“B”). Exit the elevator and follow the hallway straight ahead to classroom NDH-063. When leaving, reverse your steps and use elevator level “1R”.
