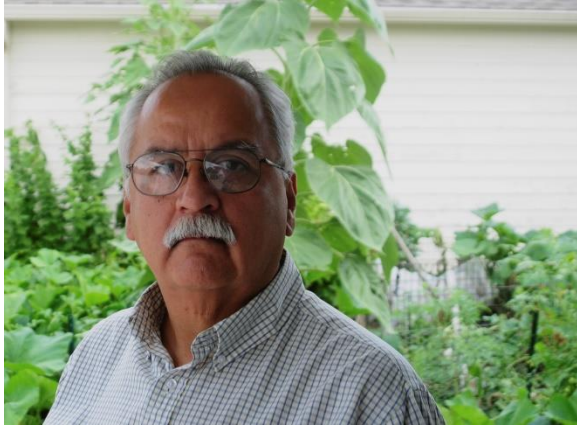




2018 Spring Retreat
