Raised Iroquois Beading

Create a Needle Case Holder using a traditional Iroquois beading technique. The Iroquois developed this technique during the Victorian Era to sell beading to help support their families. Learn simple Iroquois raised beading techniques and learn the history and culture of the Haudenosaunee (People of the Longhouse).

Most students will not finish in class. James has arranged for time at a local library to assist students who might need additional help to finish their project.

- materials to make a 3x4.5 inch Needle Case Holder

Supplies and/or Tools to bring to class:

- scissors or thread cutter
- beading mat or work surface
- bead scoop or triangle, optional
- task light and extension cord, optional
- magnifiers, optional
