The twisted lady necklace is a wonderful necklace that can be worn by anyone. Once you make this necklace you'll have to have the matching bracelet. The secret to success with this project is all in the love of beads and the warmth of the leather when you wear it.

4 colorways are offered:

- turquoise/bronze leather
- mustard picasso/natural brown leather
- red/olive leather
- pink luster/old gold leather

Optional Kit Contains:

- 3g 8/0 seed beads (color A)
- 2g Twin beads or SuperDuo beads (color B)
- 5.5g 3mm cube beads (color C)
- 0.5g 11/0 seed beads (color D)
- 12 feet leather cord, 1.5mm diameter
- 2 13mm fiber tips (the metal piece you attach to the end of leather cord so that you may connect it to a clasp)
- 1 clasp
- 2 medium jumprings (6 mm)
- beading thread – Wildfire or Fireline, 6 or 8 lb., 10 yards
- 1 set of earwires
- 6 large jumprings (10mm or larger)
- 4 figure-8 connectors or 4 medium jumprings (round or oval)
- 2 small jumprings (4 or 5 mm)
- 2 headpins (2 inches long)
- 2 4mm beads

Students must bring all items listed for the kit if not purchasing the kit.

Supplies and/or Tools to bring to class:

- beading needle – size 10
- scissors or thread cutter
- chain nose pliers



- flat nose pliers
- round nose pliers
- wire nippers/cutters
- beading mat or work surface
- thread zapper, optional
- bead scoop or triangle, optional
- task light and extension cord, optional
- magnifiers, optional
