

# Jump Ring/Bead Bracelet

## Materials Needed:

- 1mm leather cord – 30 inches
- 1 button for closure, either shank or 2-4 hole
- 6° Beads – 80 each or 7 grams
- 6mm Jump Rings – 75 each



Thread the 1mm leather through the button shank and tie a simple overhand knot.

Or,

Thread the 1mm leather through one of the holes and back down another hole and tie a simple overhand knot. (not shown)



Thread one 6° on one strand and slide up to the button. Thread one jump ring through BOTH strands and slide to button.



Continue sliding 6° beads on alternating leather strands and a jump ring over both strands until you reach a comfortable length.

Keep smoothing out the strand so it lies flat.

Check your work to avoid mistakes!

Save about 1" for a closure.

Tie a simple overhand knot at the end of your strand, and then another knot the width of your button away. Make sure you can slide the button thru the gap.

If you like, use additional beads to decorate the ends.

Trim the ends of the leather cord.

For additional strength, add a drop of SuperGlue to all the knots (not provided).
